

**Medical Mission Trip to COPE Ministry
West Pokot, Kenya
July 16th-30th 2026
Applications are due by December 31st 2025**

Who: We are seeking any Christian medical professional! This would be open to nurses, doctors, dentists, medical assistants, PT/OT professionals, EMTs, etc. Wound care experience would be beneficial. Diagnostic equipment will be limited, so we are especially interested in doctors who are comfortable getting creative and treating in an effective and sustainable way for those living without access to follow-up care. Being able to bring at least a few of your own assessment tools would be a big perk!

What: A medical clinic in rural Kenya where medical resources are scarce. The tentative itinerary would include 5 days of working in a medical clinic set up on the COPE Ministry compound, working under the licenses of local doctors. You will also get to experience much of the local culture, spend time with the children living in our rescue home, and helping with a feeding program and childrens' outreach. Each individual will be responsible for gather a list of donations to help stock our medical dispensary for the clinic.

This region of Kenya can have extreme temperatures, malaria carrying mosquitos, typhoid, minimal access to medical care, and very limited access to electricity and running water. There is limited electricity on the compound that can be used to charge phones and wifi during daylight hours. The compound has a few modern toilets and running water. There is no air conditioning of any kind. The schedule requires early mornings and sometimes long days. This will be a strenuous trip, but has the potential to be amazing and life changing.

Where: COPE Ministry Compound in Kacheliba, West Pokot, Kenya

How: We will have monthly meetings leading up to the trip to help plan and prepare the team for the experience. There will be a zoom option available, but in person meetings will be very helpful for bonding as a team and learning about the medical needs in the region. It is essential that you participate in as many of these meetings as possible.

The estimated cost for this trip including air fare, lodging, ground transportation, food on compound, and the half day safari is \$3800. This amount will be due by **April 30th 2026**. Extra expenses would include typhoid vaccine, malaria preventative, visa, souvenirs, eating out during travel days, and tips for the matrons who will take care of the team on the compound.
